1 Electress Maria Anna of Bavaria  
(January 13, 1610 in Graz –  
September 25, 1665 in Munich)  
Daughter of Emperor Ferdinand II of Austria  
and Maria Anna,  
daughter of Duke Wilhelm V of Bavaria  
Married in 1635 to Elector Maximilian I  
of Bavaria in his second marriage

2 Elector Maximilian I of Bavaria  
(since 1623)  
(April 17, 1573 in Munich –  
September 27, 1651 in Ingolstadt)  
Son of Duke Wilhelm V of Bavaria and Renata of  
Lorraine  
Married 1595 in first marriage with Princess  
Elisabeth Renata of Lorraine  
Married 1635 in second marriage with  
Archduchess Maria Anna of Austria

3 Electress Elisabeth Renata of Bavaria  
(October 9, 1574 in Nancy –  
January 4, 1635 in Ranshofen)  
Daughter of Duke Karl III of Lorraine and Claudia  
of Valois, Princess of France and Duchess of  
Lorraine  
Married in 1595 to the later Elector Maximilian I.  
of Bavaria

4 King Ludwig II of Bavaria  
(August 25, 1845 in Nymphenburg –  
June 13, 1886 in Berg)  
Son of the later King Maximilian II of Bavaria  
and Marie of Prussia  
Unmarried

5 Duchess Renata of Bavaria  
(April 20, 1544 in Nancy –  
May 22, 1602 in Munich)  
Daughter of Duke Franz I of Lorraine and Princess  
Christina of Denmark  
Married in 1568 to the later Duke Wilhelm V.  
of Bavaria

6 Duke Wilhelm V of Bavaria the Pious  
(September 29, 1548 in Landshut –  
February 7, 1626 in Schleißheim)  
Son of Duke Albrecht V of Bavaria  
and Archduchess Anna of Austria  
Married in 1568 to Princess Renata of Lorraine

7 Duke Ferdinand Wilhelm of Bavaria  
(August 25, 1620 in Munich –  
October 23, 1629 in Munich)  
Son of Duke Albrecht VI, Landgrave of  
Leuchtenberg and Mechthild, daughter of  
Landgrave Georg Ludwig of Leuchtenberg

8 Count Palatine Johann Friedrich  
of Veldenz-Sponheim  
(January 12, 1604 in Lauterecken –  
November 30, 1632 in Augsburg)  
Son of Count Palatine Georg Gustav of Veldenz  
and his second wife Maria Elisabeth, daughter  
of Count Palatine Johann I. of Zweibrücken  
Unmarried

9 Count Palatine Klemens August  
of Zweibrücken  
(September 18, 1749 in Mannheim –  
June 19, 1750 in Mannheim)  
Son of Count Palatine Friedrich Michael of  
Zweibrücken and Maria Franziska Dorothea,  
daughter of Hereditary Prince Joseph Karl  
Emanuel of Palatine-Sulzbach

10 Count Palatine Friedrich Michael  
of Zweibrücken  
(February 27, 1724 in Rappoltsweiler –  
August 15, 1767 in Schwetzingen)  
Son of Count Palatine Christian III  
of Zweibrücken  
and Karoline of Nassau-Saarbrücken  
Married in 1746 to Maria Franziska Dorothea,  
daughter of Hereditary Prince Joseph Karl  
Emanuel of Palatinate-Sulzbach

11 Duke Karl August of Zweibrücken  
(October 29, 1746 in Düsseldorf –  
April 1, 1795 in Mannheim)  
Son of Count Palatine Friedrich Michael  
of Zweibrücken and Maria Franziska Dorothea  
of Palatinate-Sulzbach  
Married in 1774 to Maria Amalie Anna, daughter  
of Elector Friedrich Christian of Saxony

12 Electress Elisabeth Maria Auguste of the  
Palatinate and Bavaria  
(January 17, 1721 in Mannheim –  
August 17, 1794 in Weinheim an der Bergstrasse)  
Daughter of Count Palatine Joseph Karl of  
Palatinate-Sulzbach  
and Elisabeth of Palatinate-Neuburg  
Married in 1742 to the later Elector Karl Theodor  
of the Palatinate

13 Hereditary Prince Joseph Karl Emanuel  
of Palatinate-Sulzbach  
(November 2, 1694 in Sulzbach –  
July 18, 1729 in Oggersheim)  
Son of Count Palatine Theodor Eustach  
of Palatinate-Sulzbach and Marie Eleonore  
of Hesse-Rotenburg  
Married in 1717 to Elisabeth Auguste Sophie,  
daughter of Elector Karl III Philipp of the  
Palatinate

14 Hereditary Princess Elisabeth Auguste  
Sophie of Palatinate-Sulzbach  
(March 17, 1693 in Brieg, Silesia –  
January 30, 1728 in Mannheim)

Daughter of Elector Karl III Philipp of Palatinate-Neuburg and Luise Charlotte Radziwill  
Married in 1717 to Hereditary Prince Joseph Karl Emanuel, of Palatinate-Sulzbach

in front of the coffins of their parents:

Count Palatine Karl Philipp August of Sulzbach  
(March 17, 1718 – March 31, 1724)

Count Palatine Karl Philipp August of Sulzbach  
(November 24, 1725 – May 6, 1727)

15 Duke Eugène de Beauharnais  
of Leuchtenberg (since 1817)  
(September 3, 1781 in Paris –  
February 21, 1824 in Munich)

Adopted son of Emperor Napoleon I of France  
Married in 1806 to Auguste Amalie of Bavaria,  
daughter of King Max I Joseph of Bavaria

16 Duchess Auguste Amalie of Leuchtenberg  
(June 21, 1788 in Strasbourg –  
May 13, 1851 in Munich)

Daughter of King Maximilian I Joseph of Bavaria  
and his first wife Auguste Wilhelmine  
of Hesse-Darmstadt  
Married in 1806 to Eugène de Beauharnais, Duke  
of Leuchtenberg and Prince of Eichstätt

Princess Carolina Clotilde (January 15, 1816 in  
Munich – January 25, 1816 in Munich)

17 Duchess Theresia Emanuela of Bavaria  
(July 22, 1723 in Munich –  
March 27, 1743 in Frankfurt am Main)  
Daughter of Duke Ferdinand Maria Innozenz  
of Bavaria  
and Maria Anna Karoline of Palatinate-Neuburg  
Unmarried

18 Prince Adalbert Wilhelm Georg Ludwig  
of Bavaria  
(July 19, 1828 in Munich –  
September 21, 1875 in Nymphenburg)  
Fourth son of King Ludwig I of Bavaria  
and Therese of Saxe-Hildburghausen  
Married in 1856 to Infanta Amalia Felipe Pilar  
of Spain

19 Princess Amalia Felipe Pilar of Bavaria  
(October 12, 1834 in Madrid –  
August 27, 1905 in Nymphenburg)  
Daughter of Infante Francisco de Paula of Spain  
and Luisa Carlota of Sicily  
Married in 1856 to Prince Adalbert of Bavaria

20 Duchess Theresia Benedicta of Bavaria  
(December 6, 1725 in Munich –  
March 29, 1743 in Frankfurt am Main)  
Daughter of Elector Karl Albrecht of Bavaria and  
Archduchess Maria Amalie of Austria  
Unmarried

21 Princess Louise Viktoria Sophie of Bavaria  
(July 19, 1869 Bushy House near Teddington –  
February 4, 1952 in Munich)

Daughter of Prince Ferdinand Philippe of Orléans  
and Duchess Sophie in Bavaria  
Married in 1891 to Prince Alfons of Bavaria

22 Prince Alfons of Bavaria  
(January 24, 1862 in Nymphenburg –  
January 8, 1933 in Munich)

Son of Prince Adalbert of Bavaria  
and Amalia Felipe Pilar of Spain  
Married in 1891 to Louise Viktoria Sophie  
Princess of Orléans

23 Princess Maria de la Paz of Bavaria  
(June 23, 1862 in Madrid –  
December 4, 1946 in Nymphenburg)

Daughter of titular King Francisco and reigning  
Queen Isabella II of Spain  
Married in 1883 to Prince Ludwig Ferdinand  
of Bavaria

24 Prince Ludwig Ferdinand of Bavaria  
(October 22, 1859 in Madrid –  
November 23, 1949 in Nymphenburg)

Son of Prince Adalbert of Bavaria and Amalia  
Filipina del Pilar de Borbón, Infanta of Spain  
Married in 1883 to Infanta Maria de la Paz of Spain

25 King Otto of Bavaria  
(April 27, 1848 in Munich –  
October 11, 1916 in Fürstenried)

Second son of King Maximilian II of Bavaria  
and Marie of Prussia  
Unmarried

26 Duchess Mauritia Febronia of Bavaria  
(April 12, 1652 in Chateau-Thierry –  
June 20, 1706 in Türkheim, Swabia)

Daughter of Frédéric-Maurice de La Tour  
d'Auvergne and Éléonore de Bergh  
Married in 1668 to Duke Maximilian Philipp  
Hieronymus of Bavaria

27 Duke Maximilian Philipp Hieronymus  
of Bavaria  
(September 30, 1638 in Munich –  
March 20, 1705 in Türkheim, Swabia)

Son of Elector Maximilian I of Bavaria  
and Maria Anna of Austria  
Married in 1668 to Mauritia Febronia de La Tour  
d'Auvergne
